Repent and Believe

The second major work of the missionary after conversion is the process of making disciples. Short-term discipleship focuses on the foundation of the faith. It is the beginning of the spiritual growth of the new believer. These short-term lessons would be considered the milk of the Word. They are also the direct commands of Jesus to His disciples and hold significant importance.

Repent and believe must be taught to make sure the convert truly understands what they believe. They must understand that they are sinners and need a savior. They must also understand that they must believe the gospel for true salvation, that Jesus died, was buried and rose again for their sin. His blood atones for all their sin.

Baptism

Baptism is a very important step for the new Antemoro believer. They take it seriously and celebrate it as a victory. However, they are somewhat confused as to its relations to salvation. Many believe it is part of the salvation experience. To address this we create investigative scenarios to provide clarification. They must understand that it is only the blood of Christ that can atone for sin and baptism is a physical testimony of an already spiritual truth in their lives.

The Lord Supper

The Lord Supper is one of the seven commands of Jesus to His followers to remember His finished work on the cross. It is taken to remember the great cost that Jesus paid to redeem us from our sin and make us His children. We are commanded to do this until He returns, remembering that He promised to return for us. It is a remembrance of the great and eternal hope we have by faith in Christ and His gospel.

Make Disciples

Giving

We are commanded to take notice that the placement of our treasure reveals the position of our hearts. The believer is commanded to show generosity and kindness to all men because this may lead to their repentance. Giving is a physical demonstration of a spiritual truth of redemption. Giving show us to be unselfish and that we have a divine heart, spirit and mind.

Prayer
